Our master auctioneer is already at work and preparing a fabulous auction with around 100 rare lilacs to auction off. Attending the convention gives you this unique opportunity to acquire rare lilacs that you will not be able to buy on the market. Do not miss it!

Kelly Applegate Lilac Collection By Mark L. DeBard, Convention Co-Chair

ILS Board Member Kelly Applegate has what is likely the largest private collection of lilac cultivars in North America. (Although the similar-sized Sunny Fields Botanical Park in Michigan is privately owned by ILS member Bill Horman, it is routinely open to the public).

Kelly's collection has over 300 cultivars. It is located in very rural Princeton, Minnesota (pop. 5000), and about a one-hour drive north of Minneapolis. The lilacs are laid out on a few acres of flat land, beautifully spaced about 12 feet apart, with circular edge retainers surrounding the mulched bases, with grass for ground cover between the lilacs, all surrounding his charming home. They are meticulously labeled with excellent metal and plastic signs denoting the cultivar and species.

The collection is mostly *S. vulgaris* and *S. ×hyacinthiflora*. Most are mature shrubs, but an expanding area has smaller, younger shrubs that are also labeled nicely, with purple martin birdhouses scattered among them. Kelly annually hosts a day-long open house primarily for his neighbors to enjoy the lilacs.

This year, for the first time ever, ILS members are greatly privileged to be able to see this private collection that is unique in size and breadth for North American lilacs.

Minnesota University Landscape Arboretum By Mark L. DeBard, Convention Co-Chair

The ILS will spend an exciting day on May 26 at the Minnesota Landscape Arboretum in Chaska, Minnesota, 10 miles from our hotel in Eden Prairie. Our discounted admission includes a box lunch with a flowerpot plus a 10% discount at the Gift & Garden Store.

The arboretum, founded in 1958, is a 1200-acre public garden with over 500,000 visitors/year and 30,000 paid members. It has nationally recognized tree collections with a Three-Mile Walk over paved paths.

The arboretum includes 44 plant collections, extensive works of art, 28 lush display gardens featuring roses, peonies, irises, and clematis, an All-America Selections Garden, a cold-hardy produce demonstration farm, and beautiful annual display gardens. It has almost 6000 unique species, cultivars, and hybrids.

The Hueg Lilac Collection is the oldest collection at the Arboretum. It is located an easy walk across the street from the visitor center and the bus parking, making it very accessible. It features 179 specimens, 123 cultivars, and a tremendous 26 species for the seventh largest display of taxons in the country.
